

Fixing the Pop-up Blocker in Chrome

Google Chrome prevents pop-ups from automatically appearing and cluttering your screen. Whenever the browser blocks a pop-up for a site, an icon like this appears in the address bar. Click on it to see the pop-ups that have been blocked or to manage pop-up settings for the site.



The fastest way to stop this for a site is to click on “Always allow pop-ups from ...” when it happens.

To see **blocked pop-ups** for a site:

1. Click the “X” to see a list of those sites that have been blocked.
2. Click the link for the one that you’d like to see.
3. To always see pop-ups for that site, select “Always show...” and it will be added to the exceptions list which you can manage in the Content Settings dialog of *Chrome* Preferences.



To **manually** allow pop-ups from a site:

1. Click the *Chrome* menu on the browser toolbar.
2. Select **Settings**. Click **Show Advanced settings** (at bottom of screen).
3. In “Privacy”, click the **Content settings** button.
4. In “Pop-ups”, click **Manage exceptions**.



To **Allow** all pop-ups

1. Click the *Chrome* menu.
2. Select **Settings**. Click **Show Advanced settings**.
3. In “Privacy”, click **Content settings**.
4. In “Pop-ups”, select **Allow all sites to show pop-ups.**
